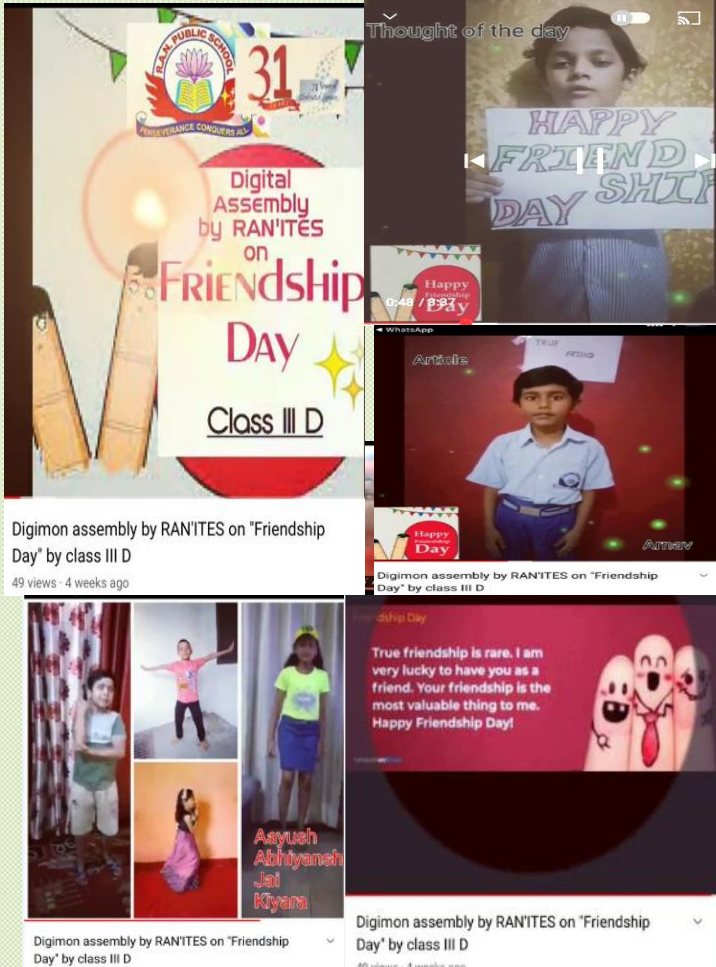
The specialty of Ganesha Chaturthi

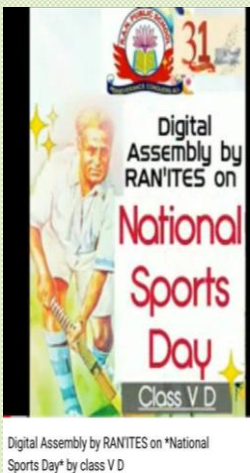

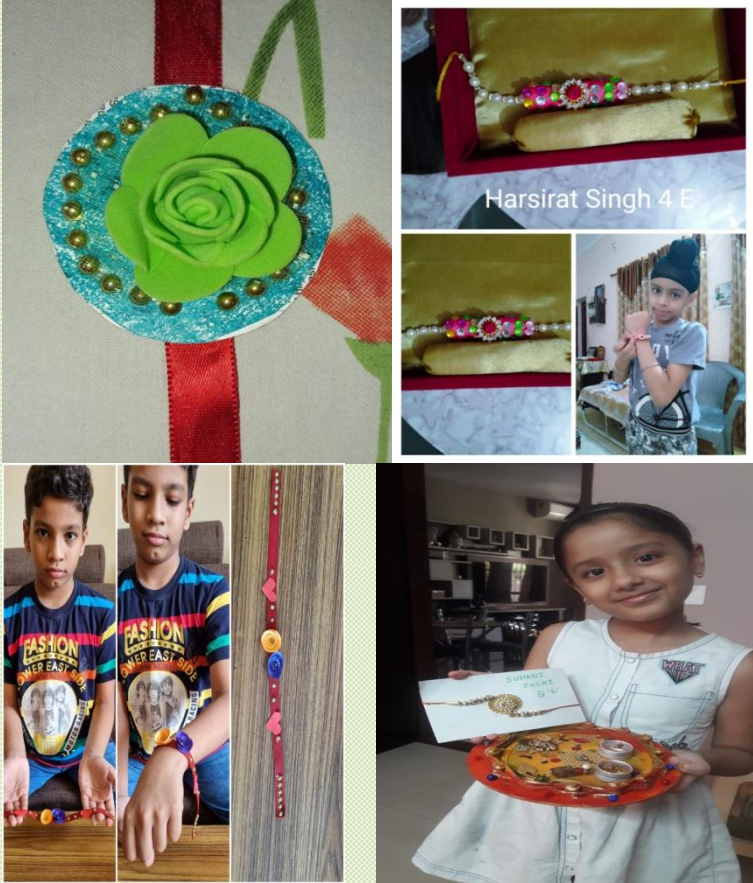
